CAMPGROUND RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. Speed limit within the campground is 5 MPH. NO BURNOUTS, LOUD PIPES or ANY UNNECESSARY NOISE INSIDE THE CAMPGROUND !!!!!!!!!!
- NO VISITORS ARE ALLOWED IN THE CAMPGROUND. THIS INCLUDES FRIENDS, RELATIVES, AQUIANTANCES, or THE PERSON YOU JUST PICKED UP, NO EXCEPTIONS; THE CAMPGROUND IS FOR PAYING CUSTOMERS ONLY. IF YOU ALLOW NON_PAYING VISITORS ON YOUR SITE, YOU AS WELL AS YOUR GUESTS WILL BE REMOVED WITHOUT A REFUND.
- 3. All fires must be kept small and within the fire rings NO BONFIRES!
- 4. Destruction of property will not be tolerated. No trees or branches should be cut at any point. <u>FIREWOOD WILL</u> <u>BE FOR SALE.</u>
- 5. Quiet time is from 1:00 A.M. to 7:00 A.M.
- 6. Please do not make any unnecessary mess in the bath facilities. RESPECT THE OTHER CAMPERS RIGHT TO USE A CLEAN FACILITY.
- 7. Check-in time is before 8 P.M. NO ONE SHOWING UP AFTER 8:00 P.M. WILL BE ALLOWED IN UNTIL 8:00 A.M.
- 8. Alcoholic beverages must be kept at your site. Minors are not allowed to possess or drink alcohol beverages anywhere in the campground. Any staff member requesting a beer should get one free.
- 9. Campsites are clean when you arrive. Please keep them this way and dispose of your trash in the dumpsters. We have free garbage bags at the office.
- 10. If you become unruly or piss off Bob, you and your group will be thrown out immediately with no refund.
- 11. Pets are not permitted during Bike Week, this includes all reptiles and other exotic animals.
- 12. For the safety of our campers and their motorcycles, during Bike Week, we will have to restrict the amount of motor vehicles and trailers within the campground. You will be allowed to park your bikes inside the campground, next to your campsite. If you have not listed your vehicle on this form, it will not be allowed in the campground.
- 13. No firearms, ammunition, gun powder, fireworks, or weapons of any kind will be allowed in the campground.
- 14. During Bike Week all campers will be given an ID bracelet at registration and must wear the ID bracelet on their right wrist **AT ALL TIMES**.
